Weekend Schedule (Must attend both days)

Day one: Facilitation Skills

Through exercises, practice and feedback, this workshop will focus on:

- ❖ Strategies and skills for creating positive, participatory learning environments and effectively managing discussion
- ❖ Ways to address individual learning styles through workshop design/facilitation
- ❖ Staying balanced (talking and listening, being active and being receptive, tuning in)
- ❖ Common facilitation challenges and strategies for successfully dealing with them

Day Two: Using our Heads in hands on Training

This highly participatory day explores the Experiential Learning Cycle, to help you

- ❖ Better understand the rationale for using experiential learning methodology
- ❖ Become familiar with the complete Experiential Learning Cycle through being a participant in two engaging structured learning activities
- ❖ learn and analyze the various stages of the critically important and oft-neglected 'debriefing' process
- ❖ Practice designing some debriefing questions for an activity
